



NCCP INSTRUCTION BEGINNER CANSKATE COACH PATHWAY

Pre-Requisites:

- Be a registered Skate Canada member
- Be at least 16 years of age
- Passed at least one complete Junior Bronze STARSkate Test*

*If you do not meet this requirement please contact your Section Course Administrator

Coach Registration Requirements:

Five CEP points on a two-year cycle, Valid First Aid, Back Check, Making Ethical Decisions on-line evaluation (coach.ca)

Professional Development Opportunities (Sport Specific):

National Coaches Conference, Continuous Education Program, National Performance Centre Seminars, Section/Club Seminars, CanSkate University

CanSkate Pre-Course Online Module

- Complete within approximately 60 days to the start date of the NCCP CanSkate course
- Must be completed successfully before attending the course.



Attend 3-Day CanSkate Course

- Complete all in class and on-ice assignments

CANSKATE COACH IN-TRAINING

CanSkate Trained Video Submission

- Register as a Skate Canada Professional Coach
- Successfully complete the NCCP CanSkate Trained Evaluation Portfolio
- Recommended to be completed within ONE YEAR of achieving an In-Training status.

CANSKATE COACH TRAINED

To finish certification, Coaches can decide to certify as a CanSkate Coach or continue their NCCP Certification. Coaches are recommended to achieve a **CanSkate Coach Certified** status or a **Primary STARSkate Trained** status within **TWO** years of achieving an In-Training status.

- Successfully complete the CanSkate Certified Evaluation Portfolio
